

The University of Southern Mindanao (formerly the Mindanao Institute of Technology) is located less than one kilometer from the National Highway in the Municipality of Kabacan, Cotabato Province. Kabacan is nearly at the geographical center of Mindanao and is accessible from any part of the island through the North-South Cagayan de Oro–General Santos City and East-West Davao–Cotabato City national highways, which intersect in the town.

The land on which the University is situated was formerly the Rio Grande Rubber Estate, covering an area of 1,024 hectares. The university's land grant area is designated for carrying out its mandated functions of instruction, research, extension, and production. The academic zone is strategically located near the center of this land grant area, occupying 88 hectares in a setting conducive to learning. This area houses the various academic buildings, sports complex, administrative offices, hospital, dormitories, cottages, and other facilities.

The University Development Plan (available from S.Y. 2014-15 to 2024-25) outlines the university's strategic direction for growth and ongoing development. The plan addresses the following goals:

- a) Generating additional funds for the university.
- b) Offering new educational programs to meet the labor needs of both domestic and international markets.
- c) Implementing programs to address the increasing demand for improved information management and communication technologies, and to support government programs aimed at poverty alleviation.
- d) Enhancing the university's organizational structure and administrative procedures through the creation of additional offices that cater to specific needs and performance monitoring across various areas.
- e) Emphasizing the creation of a conducive study environment by improving security, campus landscaping, installing drinking fountains, enhancing restroom facilities, adding ATM services, and ensuring clearer, well-maintained classrooms.


This development plan underscores the university's commitment to providing quality education and a supportive environment for its students.

Site Development Plan/Physical Plant Map displayed prominently in the Campus






Development Plan



Campus Zoning Map



A.2. Evidence of Land Ownership






To substantiate the legal ownership and secure the tenure of its landholdings, the University of Southern Mindanao (USM) maintains essential legal documents, namely:

- Transfer Certificates of Title (TCT) These documents serve as official proof that the land
 has been legally conveyed and is duly registered under the name of the University. The
 TCT affirms USM's full ownership and vested rights over the property.
- Certificates of Occupancy These certificates validate the University's lawful possession and authorized utilization of its academic, administrative, and operational facilities situated within the land grant area.




A.3. Vicinity Map





USM is situated in the Municipality of Kabacan, Cotabato Province, less than one kilometer from the National Highway. Kabacan lies near the geographical center of Mindanao and serves as a major crossroad, being accessible through the Cagayan de Oro–General Santos City (North–South) and Davao–Cotabato City (East–West) national highway routes. This central and accessible location enhances the University's connectivity to various parts of the island, making it a viable institution for students, faculty, and stakeholders from diverse regions.

The attached vicinity maps provide a clear visual reference of the University's position within the region and its proximity to major transport networks, supporting its role as a key educational and research institution in Mindanao.




Campus Vicinity Map




