



Conducted Anti-Drug and Anti-Terror Symposium	Successfully held 7 symposiums in barangays with participation from PNP Makilala and over 500 youth participants.
Established KKDAT Youth Core Groups	Formed active youth advocate groups in 7 barangays to sustain peer education in sports training
Trained Youth Leaders	Conducted Skills Training/Officiating and Sports management for at least 30 youth leaders, many of whom now assist

	in local advocacy efforts.
