Golden Panthers, USM-KCC Crickets Reign Supreme Again as Unilympics and Kaliline 2025 Overall Champion

The Unit III Golden Panthers have done it again, roaring their way to a three-peat Unilympics Overall Championship title after amassing 985 points.

Unit III, represented by the Institute of Sports, Physical Education and Recreation (ISPEAR), College of Arts and Social Sciences (CASS), College of Science and Mathematics (CSM), and College of Human Ecology and Food Sciences (CHEFS), proved unstoppable on the field and beyond.

Unit IV Bagani Warriors racked up a total of 712 points after strategic wins in both men’s and women’s chess and a dazzling display in dancesports to secure 1st Runner-Up.

Meanwhile, Unit I Valiant Bakunawa clawed their way to third, closing their campaign with 606 points.

Unit II Azulan Claws and Unit V Maroon Ravens rounded out the leaderboard with 402 and 221 points, securing the 4th and 5th spots, respectively.

Meanwhile, the USM-Kidapawan City Campus (KCC) Crickets stole the spotlight in this year’s Kaliline Festival after besting 14 competitors.

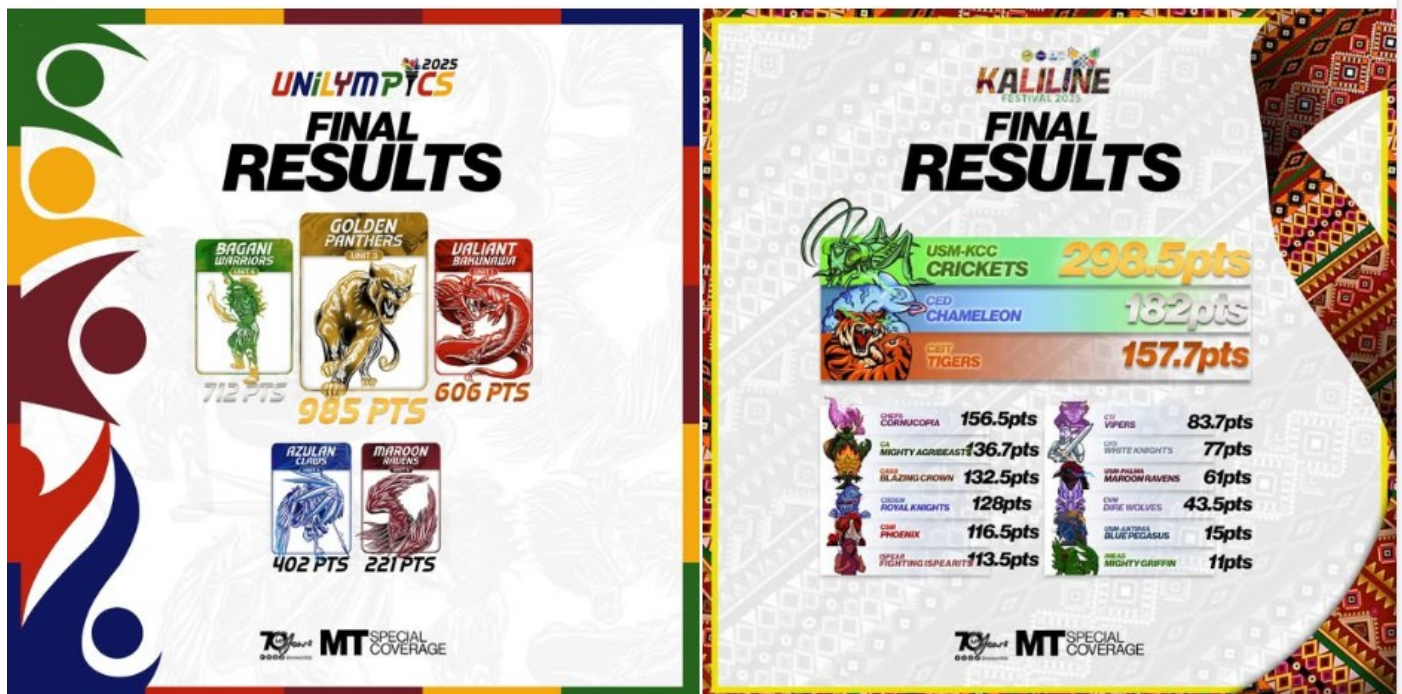
With power-packed performances across the board, the Crickets gathered a total of 298.5 points, dominating the storytelling, pagkukuwento, pagsusulat ng sanaysay, dagliang talumpati, and quiz bowl.

Trailing behind in second place is the College of Education (CED) Chameleons with 182 points, clinching victories in essay writing and in situ painting.

The College of Engineering and Information Technology (CEIT) Tigers captured the third spot, while the College of Human Ecology and Food Sciences (CHEFS) Cornucopia placed fourth with 157.7 and 156.5 points, respectively.
