It provides a clear assessment of their performance, offering feedback on both strengths and areas for improvement in a laboratory setting.

<b>Preparation &amp; Readiness</b>	Arrives on time, fully prepared with all necessary materials and a clear understanding of the task.	Arrives on time, with most necessary materials, and demonstrates general understanding of the task.	Arrives on time but lacks some materials or needs additional time to understand the task.	Arrives late or unprepared, with minimal understanding of the task.
<b>Safety Practices</b>	Consistently follows all laboratory safety procedures and uses equipment properly.	Follows most safety procedures, with occasional reminders needed.	Inconsistently follows safety procedures; requires frequent reminders.	Neglects safety procedures, posing potential risk.
<b>Technical Skills</b>	Demonstrate advanced skills, handling equipment confidently and efficiently.	Demonstrates good skills with equipment, completing tasks competently.	Demonstrates basic skills but may need assistance with certain tasks.	Struggles with basic technical skills require constant assistance.
<b>Task Execution</b>	Executes the task with precision, showing a thorough understanding of the process and rationale.	Completes the task with few errors and a good understanding of the process.
