CHULYONG LEE**, hereinafter referred to as "**CAMP**";

UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN MINDANAO (USM), a level IV state University, created and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with office and postal address at Kabacan, Cotabato, duly represented by its President, **FRANCISCO GIL N. GARCIA, Ph.D.**, hereinafter referred to as "**USM**".

WHEREAS, CAMP recognizes the need for technical assistance, particularly in the field of sustainable land management on durian cropping-system for its approved project with Korea International Cooperation Agency (KOICA) and Mindanao Development Authority (MinDA) entitled "Developing Sustainable Agricultural Environment through the Organization of Durian Producers in Mindanao, Philippines";

WHEREAS, USM is a Center of Excellence in Agriculture since the year 2015. One of its four-fold functions is Extension, facilitated by a technical pool of experts capable of addressing the project's objective of developing site-specific nutrient and land management as well as internal quality control system (IQCS) manual for sustainable production of durian.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties thereto agree as follows:

I. Purpose

This Memorandum of Understanding is anchored on the objective of establishing a collaboration between parties and to formalize the partnership in the foregoing implementation activities of the above-mentioned project.

II. Roles and Obligation of the Parties

A. CAMP shall:

1. Coordinate with USM technical experts in the planning and implementation of activities of the project;
2. Furnish USM a copy of the technical accomplishment report of the project;
3. Be accountable for the travel and logistical expenses of USM expert/s including equipment to be purchased and other service fees incurred in the conduct of the approved activities for the project;
4. Acknowledge USM in all reports, articles, and media releases of the experiment/ study/ activities conducted;
5. Allow USM technical experts to publish the result of the experiment/ study as the corresponding author;
6. Allow and support USM students to conduct thesis studies in the experimental sites of the project;
7. Support the USM technical expert in undertaking activities in exploring possible partnerships and linkages on research, capacity training, and other initiatives offered in South Korea to support USM's priority research, development, and extension agenda.

B. USM shall:

1. Provide the necessary technical experts with the following functions:
 - a. To assist in formulating the detailed research study outline; and
 - b. To assist in facilitating research and development activities in line with the objectives of the project.
2. Allow travel of the technical experts in relation to the implementation of the approved project activities charged to the CAMP ASIA Project.

III. Miscellaneous

1. This partnership shall remain effective for the duration of the project;
2. All data information generated from the results of the project and activities will be owned by both parties and there will be free access on the use of data for any relevant research of any of the partners.

IV. Amendments

The parties to the partnership, by mutual consent and in writing, and for as long as it is within the purview of the law, may add, modify, amend, delete any word(s), phrase(s), sentence(s), or article(s) in this partnership.

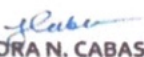
