There were around twenty (20) participants composed of barangay officials, day care workers, barangay nutrition scholars, and students. Mr. Galas demonstrated how to create a graph using Microsoft Excel and told the participants to follow each step. Ms. Genotiva and Ms. Flores facilitated the participants and their inquiries. At the end of the topic, the participants were able to create their graphs and save their document. The speaker emphasized that graphs are a good way to present data and the participants appreciated its importance. Snacks followed after the first activity for the day courtesy of the Barangay Captain Mr. Roy L. Valdez. While having snacks, the participants filled up the Resource Person Evaluation form and submitted the forms to the coordinator.


Figure 1 shows the client feedback on Resource Person delivering the topic Working with Spreadsheet using MS Excel.

OVERALL TRAINING EVALUATION

Project Title: RVG 4 ICT: Rural Villages on the Go for Information Communication Technology

The College of Engineering and Information Technology conducted six (6) training — workshops at Barangay Malamote, Kabacan, Cotabato last July 31, September 7, 14, 21, and 28, and October 4, 2019. The training — workshops were participated by the Barangay Council, Health Workers, Day Care Workers, and other Barangay workers such as Clerk, Secretary, and Treasurer.

Figure 1 shows the client feedback on the training – workshops conducted namely: Working with MS Word and MS Excel, Making a PowerPoint Presentation, Training-workshop and implementation of Local Area Network, Connectivity for Remote Areas (ICRA), Web Presence, Participatory Mapping, and Geovisualization (PMG).

The clients who participated in the training-workshop activities appreciated most of the topic Making a PowerPoint Presentation and the accommodating Resource Person in their inquiries.

According to them, the most useful topic was Working with MS Excel. They also suggested that there should be more time for training.

As to assessment on time allocation per topic/activity and duration of the training, clients responded it as just right and the training – workshops were very relevant to them.

Figure 1 further shows an overall rating for the training – workshops. It shows that the Training Management and Secretariat achieved the highest rating of 4.875 which means Excellent, and an overall rating of 4.8125 which also means an Excellent.
