In connection, we are inviting you to continue your services to SNAPS, this time as Section Editor. This year, we already started sending submissions to a Section Editor in a related or allied field, so that only manuscripts of sufficient quality are sent out for review. Section Editors enable the Editorial Team to ensure the quality of all articles that eventually get published in SNAPS. This year, we received 24 submissions; from this, only 10 were sent for review and 5 were eventually published.

The workload is not too heavy because only articles in your field of expertise will be sent to you for a preliminary evaluation. Further, the Editorial Office will perform an initial evaluation and check for plagiarism, originality, and relevance. You are also not expected to perform a full review. The task is mainly to advise the Editorial Board on whether a submitted manuscript can be endorsed for peer review. From prior experience, we expect to send a maximum of two articles (and sometimes, none) per year to each Section Editor. If you accept our invitation, please email us your affiliation and field of specialization. We shall immediately provide a Certificate of Recognition for your services.
